

Announcement of the rules "2020-2022 Pro Ski GrandPrix"

The Rule of "Pro Ski GrandPrix" will apply from 2020 to 2022 for the WORLD SERIES:

A. Hull

- A1. Hull watercraft maximum length of 97 inches. +max. 5 inches for pump and or ride plate.
- A2. Hull watercraft width must be between 20 inches and 30.12 inches, including bumper.
- A3. Hull watercraft height cannot exceed 33.46 inches measuring from the lowest point of the hull to handle pole in its position rested against the hood.

B. Engine

- B1. 4Stroke normally aspirated max 1630cc.
- B2. 2Stroke engines MAX.1300cc.
- B3. 4Stroke turbo or supercharged MAX.1100cc. with 8psi boost limit.
- B4. 3 cylinders MAX only allowed for turbo or supercharged 4Stroke engine.

C. Weight

- C1. Weight with full fuel tank cannot exceed 225 kg (496 lb) whether the watercraft is dry or wet.
